

UFC 75: Quinton Jackson vs Dan Henderson

Newly crowned Light-Heavyweight Champion Quinton Jackson will defend his title at UFC 75 in a unification bout of sorts against Pride Light-Heavyweight Champion Dan Henderson. Henderson is 37 years old but he is a vicious Greco Roman wrestler that is considered legitimate bad ass. BetUS.com has Quinton Jackson -140 odds against Dan Henderson in their UFC 75 fight. Henderson, 22-5, also has a meat cleaver right hand that can turn the lights out on most any fighter. Dan Henderson weighed in at a lean and hard 204 lbs. but in this bout he must be considered the smaller man. Quinton Jackson, 27-6, is built like a wrecking ball and will own an advantage in strength over Henderson. Quinton Jackson is a Muay-Thai striker that also owns some good if not terrific ground skills. While most of the betting money has moved on the underdog Dan Henderson I believe that Jackson has the look of a special fighter and he should get a win over the Pride Champion. On the UFC 75 undercard I spotted a great value bet in the Alessio Sakara vs Houston Alexander fight. Alexander, 7-1, is an explosive guy that recently demolished a quality foe in Keith Jardine. Italian Sakara, 15-5-1, is a relative unknown but he is a former pro boxer that has heavy hands. Sakara has been steadily improving with his ground game and he has much more experience than Alexander. Look for Sakara too put his name on the UFC map in this fight with a KO at UFC 75.
