B.J. "The Prodigy" Penn has had two fights out of seventeen that have gone the distance throughout his MMA career. Both fights were early on in his career, the first was UFC 35 when he lost by decision to Jans Pulver. The second was in UFC 41, against Caol Uno, when it was deemed a draw. He has seven fights that have ended in the third, three in the second and five in the first. His MMA record is 12W-4L-1D. Penn is a well conditioned, strong, submission expert who can stand with the best of them. It&rsquo;s been smooth sailing from here on in for Penn.

Sean "Muscle Shark" Sherk is an incredibly strong man with muscle bulging from every limb on his body. Thanks to his recent steroid scandal. Anyways, his last two fights have gone the distance with him winning by Unanimous Decision. UFC 64 he took Kenny Florian all the way and UFC 73 he went the distance with Hermes Franca. He had a five rounder back in 2003 in UFC 42 when he lost to Matt Hughes by decision. So you know he doesn&rsquo;t go down against tougher competitors. He's had a ton of fights, his overall MMA record is 32W-2L-1D and UFC is 6-2.
