

NFL Betting Preview: New York Giants vs New York Jets

The New York Giants take on Brett Favre and the New York Jets in the battle for bragging rights in the "Big Apple" when the two teams collide at Giants Stadium (7:00 PM ET) Saturday. The last time the Giants saw a Brett Favre led team was in the NFC Championship game in Green Bay last January. Oddsmakers at online betting giant Bodog (Bodoglife.com) have installed the Jets the favorite as a -3 point chalk favorite with an EVEN betting price. The price of a wager on the Giants at +3 is at -120. (\$120 to win \$100). The betting total is holding at 38 (-110). The Giants are getting 64 percent of the betting action ATS while 54 percent of total betting is falling UNDER the posted (38) total. The Giants earned their first win of the 2008 preseason when they defeated the Cleveland Browns, 37-34, in Giants Stadium on Monday night. The Giants covered the betting spread as a PICK while the total went OVER the posted 36 points. The Jets last played Aug. 16 in Giants Stadium losing SU to the Washington Redskins 10-13 and failing to cover ATS as a -3 point favorite. In the game, the 23 points scored fell UNDER the posted 36. In two games played this pre-season, the Giants are 1-0-1 ATS and 1-1 in total betting. The Jets are 1-1 ATS and 1-1 in total betting. The two teams have faced each other every summer since 1969 with the Jets leading the preseason series, 20-18-1. The Giants are 2-2 in preseason play vs. the Jets under Tom Coughlin. The Giants have won their last four regular season games against the Jets and hold a 7-4 lead in the series. The two teams last played on Oct. 7, 2007, when the Giants defeated the visiting Jets, 35-24.
