

## Jacksonville Jaguars vs Houston Texans NFL Week 4 Picks

The Jacksonville Jaguars (1-2) got their first win of the season last week against the Colts, while the Houston Texans (0-2) struggle to get their first. The Jacksonville Jaguars play host to the Houston Texans, Sunday September 28, at Municipal Stadium. NFL oddsmakers at Sportsbook.com have the Jacksonville Jaguars as -7 ½ point home favorites over the Houston Texans with the over/under listed at 42 points. The Jaguars beat the Colts on the road 23-21 after Josh Scobee kicked a 51 yard field goal. QB David Garrard made 16 of 22 passes for 167 yards with one interception. He has one touchdown pass with 547 yards and four interceptions. RB Fred Taylor and RB Maurice Jones-Drew each ran for over 100 yards, Jones-Drew also had four catches for 59 yards. The Jags are averaging 16.3 ppg and their allowing 19.3 ppg. Their offense is ranked 24th with 278 total yards a game and the majority of their yardage coming from their 13th ranked running game that averages 122 yards per-game. They average a low 156 passing yards a game. On defense they are ranked 14th allowing 306 yards a game, their pass and rush defense is ranked 17th. The Jags are 1-2-0 ATS and 1-2 over/under.

The Texans lost 12-31 to the Titans on the road. QB Matt Schaub made a low 17 of 37 passes with three interceptions. RB Steve Slaton was their top rusher with 18 carries for 116 yards and a touchdown. Top receiver WR Owen Daniels had four catches for 71 yards. The Texans are averaging 14.5 ppg and their giving up a whopping 34.5 ppg. Their offense is ranked 25th with 275 total yards a game and the majority of their yardage coming from their 19th ranked running game that averages 110 yards per-game. They average 165 passing yards a game, on a good day! Their defense is great at preventing the pass, they are ranked 6th best allowing a low 155 yards a game. Problem is they give up a 27th ranked 168 rushing yards per-game. The Texans are 0-2-0 ATS, 0-2-0 over/under and they lost their last two games by +19 or greater.
