

Northern Illinois vs Eastern Michigan Betting Odds

The Northern Illinois Huskies got their first win of the season last week at the expense of Indiana State. Despite their 1-2 record, the Huskies have played a decent brand of football this year and they are sure to exceed their two win total from 2007. The Huskies will hit the road this week to face conference rival Eastern Michigan. College football odds at JustBet.com have Eastern Michigan as a +6.5 home underdog.

Northern Illinois opened the year with a road trip to Minnesota to face an improved Golden Gophers squad. They sent a clear message to their MAC brethren that they will not be a doormat this year when they took Minnesota to the wire before losing 31-27. They followed that performance up with a strong road showing against Western Michigan. Through three games the Huskies are averaging 33.7 points per game and allowing 21 per game.

Eastern Michigan sits at 1-3 on the season, their lone win coming against Indiana State as well. The Eagles have had a tough stretch since their opener, facing Michigan State, Toledo, and Maryland. They were beat in those three games by an average of 27.6 points. However, Eastern Michigan has shown an ability to move the ball on the ground and they posted 453 total yards versus the Terrapins.
