

## Iowa State vs Oklahoma State Betting Odds

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Iowa State has a difficult task ahead of them in trying to get their first conference win of the season. The Cyclones will travel to Stillwater this week to face an Oklahoma State squad coming off its first loss of the season. Iowa State will most likely have a difficult time stopping Oklahoma State's run game which is averaging 274.5 yards per game. Cowboys' running back Kendall Hunter leads the Big 12 in rushing and he racked up 161 yards against Texas last Saturday.

The Cyclones are just 2-6 on the year, and aside from a narrow loss in Ames to the Jayhawks, they have not even been competitive in conference play. Defensively, Gene Chizik's team has had problems slowing anybody, yielding 31.6 points per game and 423.3 yards per game.
