Missouri destroyed Colorado 58-0 at Faurot Field and reasserted themselves as the team to beat in the Big 12 North division. However, Baylor can certainly feel good about their future with the fantastic play of true freshman quarterback Robert Griffin. Griffin has a 143.27 passer rating and he has not thrown an interception all season long.
