NFL Week 11 Top Matchups and Odds:

NY Jets (6-3) at New England Patriots (6-3)

The Jets are in second place in the AFC East tied with the Patriots. The Jets are 2-2 SU on the road where they average 25.6 ppg and they give up an average 21.4 ppg. The Jets currently have a 14th ranked offense with a 14th ranked passing game and the ninth best ranked running game in the league. Their defense is currently ranked 10th best with their pass defense ranked 20th and their rush defense sits ranked fifth best in the league. The Pats are 4-1 SU at home where they average 30 ppg and they give up an average 13.4 ppg. The Pats currently have a 15th ranked offense in the league with a 23rd ranked passing game and the seventh best ranked running game in the league. Their defense is currently ranked 11th best with their pass defense ranked 15th and their rush defense sits ranked 12th in the league. The Pats lead the Jets 5-1 SU in their last six meetings. NFL oddsmakers at Sportsbook.com have the Pats as -3 ½ point home favs over the Jets with the over/under listed at 42 points.

Baltimore Ravens (6-3) at NY Giants (8-1)

The Ravens are tied for first place, with the Steelers, in the AFC North. They are 3-2 SU on the road where they average 25.6 ppg and they give up an average 21.4 ppg. The Ravens currently have a 16th ranked offense with a 28th ranked passing game and the third best ranked running game in the league. Their defense is currently ranked second best with their pass defense ranked 9th best and their rush defense sits ranked best in the league. The Giants have a two game lead in the NFC East over the Redskins. They are 5-0 SU at home where they average 30 ppg and they give up an average 13.4 ppg. The Giants currently have the fourth best offense in the league with a 16th ranked passing game and the best ranked running game in the league. Their defense is currently ranked third best with their pass defense ranked second best and their rush defense sits ranked seventh in the league. The Giants are 2-0 SU against the Ravens in their last two meetings. NFL oddsmakers at Sportsbook.com have the Giants as -6 ½ point home favs over the Ravens with the over/under listed at 42 points.

Tennessee Titans (9-0) at Jacksonville Jaguars (4-5)

The Titans have a whopping four game lead in the AFC South. They are 4-0 SU on the road where they average 23 ppg and they give up an average 10.2 ppg. The Titans currently have a 22nd ranked offense with a 27th ranked passing game and the 6th best ranked running game in the league. Their defense is currently ranked fifth best with their pass defense ranked 11th and their rush defense sits ranked eighth best in the league. The Jaguars are in third place in the AFC South just one game back from the Colts. They are 1-3 SU at home where they average 21 ppg and they give up an average 24 ppg. The Jags currently have a 18th ranked offense with a 17th ranked passing game and a 14th ranked running game. Their defense is currently ranked 16th with their pass defense ranked 17th and their rush defense sits ranked 20th in the league. These two teams are split 3-3 SU in their last six meetings. NFL oddsmakers at Sportsbook.com have the Titans as -3 point road favs over the Jaguars with the over/under listed at 39 ½ points.

San Diego Chargers (4-5) at Pittsburgh Steelers (6-3)

The Chargers are in second place in the AFC West one game back from first place Denver. They are 1-4 SU on the road where they average 22.5 ppg and they give up an average 24.2 ppg. The Chargers currently have a 10th ranked offense with the sixth best passing game and a 25th ranked running game in the league. Their defense is currently ranked 26th with their pass defense ranked worst in the league and their rush defense sits ranked 13th in the league. The Steelers are tied for first place, with the Ravens, in the AFC North. They are 2-2 SU at home where they average 23.8 ppg and they give up an average 20.5 ppg. The Steelers currently have a 26th ranked offense with a 24th ranked passing game and a 24th ranked running game. Their defense is currently ranked best in the league with their pass defense ranked best in the league and their rush defense sits second best in the league. These two teams have NOT met since the 2006 season, when the Chargers won at home. NFL oddsmakers at Sportsbook.com have the Steelers as -4 1/2 point home favs over the Chargers with the over/under listed at 43 points.

Dallas Cowboys (5-4) at Washington Redskins (6-3)

The Cowboys are in third place in the NFC East one game back from second place Washington and three back from the first place Giants. The Cowboys are 2-3 SU on the road where they average 21.4 ppg and they give up an average 25 ppg. The Cowboys currently have a 12th ranked offense with the 10th best passing game and a 11th ranked running game. Their defense is currently ranked 12th with their pass defense ranked 12th and their rush defense sits ranked 18th in the league. The Redskins are in second place and looking to close the gap on the Giants. They are 3-2 SU at home

where they average 18 ppg and they give up an average 18.8 ppg. The Redskins currently have a 11th ranked offense with a 18th ranked passing game and the fourth best running game in the league. Their defense is currently ranked fourth best in the league with their pass defense ranked eighth best in the league and their rush defense sits sixth best in the league. The Redskins lead the Cowboys 3-2 SU in their last five meetings. NFL oddsmakers at Sportsbook.com have the Redskins as +1 ½ point home dogs over the Cowboys with the over/under listed at 45 points.
