

## Oklahoma State vs Colorado Betting Odds

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The Oklahoma State Cowboys are set to take on the Colorado Buffaloes at 8:00pm ET at Folsom Field in Boulder, CO. The Big 12 battle will be televised live on ABC. College football betting odds at Sportsbook.com have the Cowboys as a +18 road favorite.

Oklahoma State is coming off a 56-20 road loss to Texas Tech and they have now dropped two of their last three contests. That, however, is more a reflection of their difficult schedule than the overall play of the team. The Cowboys, without question, are a powerhouse, as their 8-2 record indicates.

The Pokes will pose a number of problems for the Buffaloes, not the least of which is their ability to score the football. Mike Gundy's team is averaging 42.8 points per game and putting up 497.6 yards per outing.

Colorado seems to be just another Big 12 North squad lost in the shuffle. They are 5-5 on the year and just 2-4 in conference competition. They clearly lack the firepower of the conference's upper echelon teams.

The Buffaloes have been good for just 19.4 points per game and they are giving up 31.16 points per game to Big 12 schools.
