

Oklahoma vs Oklahoma State Betting Odds

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The Oklahoma Sooners are in Stillwater, OK tonight to face the Oklahoma State Cowboys. The game kicks off at 8:00pm ET and will be broadcast on ABC. This evening's contest will be the 103rd in the Bedlam Series; Oklahoma has a big upper hand in the football portion of the series with a 79-16-1 record against the Pokes.

College football betting odds at Sportsbook.com have the Cowboys listed as a +7 home underdog.

It is hard to say what will happen given the convoluted nature on the Big 12 South standings, but should Oklahoma win this evening, they may secure the title in the South and move into second place in the BCS standings. Texas fans will no doubt be up in arms should the latter take place, given the fact that the Longhorns only have one loss and that they beat the Sooners head to head back in October.

However, it is likely that the Sooners are not thinking too much about all of their potential scenarios. Oklahoma State sports a 9-2 record and has proven to be a high quality team week in and week out. Oklahoma will have their hands full with the Cowboys offense, a unit that is averaging over 41 points per game as well as 492.6 yards per game.
