

## Ohio State vs Texas Fiesta Bowl Betting Odds Alert

Point-Spreads.com is issuing a betting odds and point spreads alert for the 2009 Fiesta Bowl tonight between OhioState vs Texas. The opening line in the Fiesta Bowl had Texas as a 10.5 point favorite. The current betting odds show the Texas Longhorns -8 point favorites against Ohio State at online sportsbook giant SBG Global with the TOTAL listed at 52 Points.

"The Buckeyes and Longhorns have played just twice in their history with each team winning once," stated Point-Spreads.com Publisher Thomas Jensen when asked to comment on the 2009 Fiesta Bowl match up between OhioState vs Texas. "The Longhorns have a chance to make a statement after being pushed out of the BCS Title Game. The early betting action has been coming in on Ohio State driving the line down from 10.5 to 8 points making the Buckeyes the wise guy play of the night. Despite this line move, I believe Colt McCoy will carry the Longhorns to a victory however covering the spread might not be in his cards tonight."

The Buckeyes are 4-1 ATS in their last 5 games overall. The Buckeyes are 4-1 ATS in their last 5 vs. the Big 12. The Buckeyes are 0-4 ATS in their last 4 non-conference games. Online sportsbook SBG Global has the money line betting odds on Ohio State +250 odds.

"Ohio State features a ground oriented offensive attack that averaged 191.6 rushing yards per game and generated 28.2 points per contest during the regular season," stated Point-Spreads.com College Football Betting Expert Matt Foust when asked to comment on the 2009 Fiesta Bowl match up between Ohio State vs Texas. "The Buckeyes, however, are known more for their stout defense, that limited teams a mere 13.1 points per game and held opposing rushing attacks to a lowly 73.6 yards per outing. The Texas defense was certainly no slouch either. The tough unit held teams to an average of just 18.6 points per game in the high-flying, quick scoring Big 12 South."

The Longhorns are 6-0 ATS in their last 6 non-conference games. The Longhorns are 10-3 ATS in their last 13 games overall. The Longhorns are 2-6 ATS in their last 8 Bowl games as a favorite. The Longhorns are 1-4 ATS in their last 5 vs. the Big Ten. Online sportsbook SBG Global has the money line betting odds on Texas -300 odds.

"It's time for us to put behind us all the BCS stuff and move forward and look forward to a great game," stated Texas Longhorns head coach Mack Brown. "The BCS doesn't satisfy everybody. We've been on the positive side of it a few times. We've been on the negative side a few times... He's (Colt McCoy) been the heart of our offense. He means to this team what Vince Young meant to the one in 2005. ... I can't imagine a player that means more to his team than Colt does to ours."
