

Super Bowl XLIII MVP Betting Odds

The Pittsburgh Steelers QB Ben Roethlisberger is favorite to win Super Bowl XLIII MVP at +275 odds. Most MVPs are offensive players playing at positions that score touchdowns: quarterbacks, running backs and wide receivers. Of the 43 Super Bowl MVPs, only 8 defensive players have won the recognition. Let's take a look at who else could compete for Super Bowl XLIII MVP. The Steelers QB Ben Roethlisberger got his team to a 13-4 SU record this year; he has 17 touchdown passes for 3,314 yards with 15 interceptions in 16 starts. He has a 60% completion rate along with an 80.2 QB rating. He recently threw for 181 yards with one touchdown pass during the Steelers 35-24 playoff win over the Chargers. Ben Roethlisberger is listed at +250 to win MVP.

The Eagles QB Donovan McNabb had a lack luster regular season going 10-6 SU, but his numbers are good, but not as good as Kurt Warner. He has 23 touchdown passes for 4,216 yards with 12 interceptions in 16 starts. He has a 60.4% completion rate along with an 86.4 QB rating. In his last two playoff games he's thrown for 517 yards with two touchdown passes but three interceptions. Donovan McNabb is listed at +350 to win MVP.

The Cardinals QB Kurt Warner has had an amazing year with crazy numbers. He 30 touchdown passes for 4,583 yards with 14 interceptions in 16 starts. He has a 67.1% completion rate along with an 96.8 QB rating. In his last two playoff games he's thrown for 491 yards with four touchdown passes and two interceptions. He should've been league MVP instead of Peyton Manning. Kurt Warner is listed at +750 to win MVP.

The Ravens rookieQB Joe Flacco got his team to a 12-5 SU record; he has 14 touchdown passes for 3,106 yards with 12 interceptions in 16 starts. He has a 60.3% completion rate along with an 80.3 QB rating. I like them to make the big dance, and I can see him getting MVP honors. In his last two playoff games he's thrown for 296 yards with one touchdown pass and NO interceptions. Joe Flacco is listed at +850 odds to win MVP.
