"I think Florida Gators quarterback Tim Tebow's statement is being way overhyped," stated Point-Spreads.com BCS Odds Expert Glen Mcneil when asked to comment on the 2009 BCS Title Game between Florida Gators vs Oklahoma Sooners. "From what I understand, Tim Tebow said either during or after an interview when asked about the Big 12 defenses he said he'd love to play against one."
