Rich Franklin (-140) vs Wanderlei Silva (+110)

Rich Franklin (26-4-0) recently lost his last fight to Dan Henderson at UFC 93. He is 3-2 in his last five fights. He has excellent striking skills, good conditioning and is well-rounded. Wanderlei Silva (32-9-1) recently lost his last fight to Quinton Jackson at UFC 92. He is 2-3 in his last five fights. He has superb striking power and technique, high intensity and world-class experience.

Cain Velasquez (-205) vs Cheick Kongo (+165)

Cain Velasquez (5-0-0) recently beat Denis Stojnic at UFC Fight Night Lauzon vs Stephens. He is a perfect 3-0 in the UFC where he's won all fights by TKO. He is a well rounded fighter who has destroyed his opponents by no sooner than the second round. Cheick Kongo (24-4-1) recently beat Antonio Hardonk at UFC 97 by TKO. He is 4-1 in his last five fights. He is a tall muscular fighter with power and strength who can devastate any opponent he fights.

Mike Swick (-240) vs Ben Saunders (+190)
