"Silva also has some solid jiu-jitsu ability but he has neglected it in recent bouts. Silva has taken a lot of punishment in his career and his reflexes and punch resistance is only average at this point."

The UFC 99 betting odds at internet sportsbook Bodog.com for the main event between Rich Franklin vs Wanderlei Silva have UFC predictions on Franklin listed as a -170 odds. This line opened with Silva as a -105 favorite, however tons of money has poured in on Franklin making him a very heavy favorite.

"The one question mark in Franklin's game is his lack of jiu-jitsu ability which could hurt him against Silva," Marchetti said.

The UFC 99 picks odds for the Mirko Cro Cop Filipovic vs Mustapha Al-Turk have moved considerable from their original opening number of Cro Cop -550 betting odds. The current UFC betting odds have Cro Cop listed at -350 odds with heavy betting action pouring in on the underdog Mustapha Al-Turk.
