"I don't feel any pressure at all to make this decision. We're going to take as much time as we need."

"I think our biggest fear is we put too much into this game, we try to build this thing up to be something that it really isn't," stated Washington Huskies head coach Steve Sarkisian. "This is a Pac-10 football game and at the end of Saturday, come 4 o'clock, whether it's a W or an L, it's all the same as if it was against Stanford, or UCLA or Cal. It's worth one point, and if we try and put too much into this, there can be the repercussions after the game if it doesn't go the way we want, or if it does go the way we want."
