

Auburn vs Arkansas College Football Picks, Odds & Predictions

Auburn vs Arkansas College Football Picks, College Football Odds & College Football Predictions: Auburn looks to move to the top of the SEC West standings today as it squares off against division rival Arkansas in Fayetteville. With a win and LSU and Alabama losses, that is exactly where the Tigers will find themselves at the end of the day. The Razorbacks, meanwhile, are looking to get their first conference win of the season after losses to Georgia and Alabama. Today's game is scheduled to get underway at 12:00pm ET at Razorback Stadium (ESPN). College Football Picks at BetUS.com have the Tigers listed as a -2.5 against the spread road favorite.

Gene Chizek's Auburn squad improved to 5-0 overall and 2-0 in SEC play last weekend, scoring a 26-22 win over the Tennessee Volunteers in Knoxville. The Tigers racked up 459 yards of offense and 24 first downs in the win and they held the ball for 34:46. Auburn has featured a well-balanced offense all season long and they did the same against the Volunteers, posting 235 pass yards and 224 yards on the ground.

Senior quarterback Chris Todd has benefited greatly from Chizek's arrival at Auburn as he has thrown 12 touchdowns compared to one interception this season (5 to 6 ratio last year). He completed 19-of-32 passes against Tennessee for 218 yards and one touchdown, bringing his 2009 passer rating to a stellar 160.81.

The Tigers overall performance clearly left an impression on the typically uncouth Volunteers coach, Lane Kiffin.

"They (Auburn) are so complicated," Kiffin said. "There are so many things that they do."

Arkansas improved to 2-2 last weekend, dismantling former Southwest Conference rival Texas A&M 47-19 at Dallas Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas. The lopsided score was unusual considering the fact that A&M had more yards, more first downs, more possession time, and one fewer turnover than did the Hogs. Arkansas also spotted the Aggies a 10 point first quarter lead. However, big plays (an 85 yard fumble return and a 62 yard touchdown run) enabled Bobby Petrino's squad to get the easy win.

Quarterback Ryan Mallet bounced back from a rough outing against the Crimson Tide as he completed 17-of-27 passes for 271 yards, four touchdowns and an interception. It was the second time in the last three games that Mallet has tossed at least four touchdown passes.
