

Tim Tebow Cleared by Florida Medical Staff vs LSU

Point-Spreads.com sources have learned that Florida Gators quarterback Tim Tebow was cleared by Florida Medical Staff to play tonight vs LSU. The currently point spreads at Bodog.com have the Florida Gators -9.5 points (-105 odds). We expect this line to move north of 10 points once word gets out that Tebow can play.

In a ESPN "GameDay" interview by Tom Rinaldi, Florida Gators head coach Urban Meyer commented: "If he's ready to play, cleared to play, we're going to play him."

The opening college football point spreads at Bodog.com on the Florida Gators vs LSU Tigers Total opened up at 45 points. Currently the Gators vs Tiger Total is set at 46 points (-115 odds).

"The Gators defense will win this game for Florida," stated Point-Spreads.com College Football Betting Expert Matt Foust when asked to comment on the Florida vs LSU game kicking off tonight at 8:00 PM EST. Sure, Tebow's presence in the lineup will make things far more difficult for the Tigers, but it is probably not going to matter if Florida has 20 or 40 points. Florida's defense will keep LSU's pedestrian offense in check."

Coach Urban Meyers will decide at game time if he will play Tim Tebow tonight. Kickoff is schceduled for 8:05 PM EST live from Tiger Stadium in Baton Rouge.

"We definitely want Tebow to play," LSU tight end Richard Dickson said. "He's a great player. He does great things for the sport. He's an unbelievable competitor. It wouldn't be Florida without him."
