Minnesota vs. Penn State College Football Picks: The Penn State Nittany Lions will be looking to improve their record to 6-1 if they can pick up a win over the Minnesota Golden Gophers when the two BIG TEN schools battle at Beaver Stadium at State College Penn., Saturday afternoon in an ABC regionally televised game. Minnesota, is currently 4-2 and like Penn State, only has one conference loss in 2009.

College Football Picks oddsmakers at SBGglobal.com list the Nittany Lions as 17-chalk favorites versus Minnesota with a 46 total. Moneyline odds are currently OFF the SBG Global betting board.

The Nittany Lions are coming off a 52-3 win over Eastern Illinois, while the Golden Gophers are coming off a 35-20 win over Purdue. The Nittany Lions and Golden Gophers are meeting for the first time since 2006, with Penn State leading the series, 6-4. The teams are playing in Beaver Stadium for the first time since 2005. DeLeon Eskridge rushed for two touchdowns to lead Minnesota to a 35-20 win over Purdue Boilermakers in Week 6. The Gophers covered the 3.5-point spread, while the final score played OVER the day's posted total of 51.5.
