Clemson vs. Miami College Football Picks: A 3-3 won-loss record at the mid-way point of the 2009 college football campaign isn't what Clemson backers had in mind in the pre-season. Now that the record is a reality, folks are starting to question second year coach Dabo Swinney just as they did his predecessor Tommy Bowden last year. Well, regardless of why things are as they are - Clemson is still a dangerous football team albeit very inconsistent. That is the problem Miami faces when the Tigers roll into Land Shark Stadium for a 3:30 p.m. ACC contest.

C.J. Spiller rushed for two touchdowns to lead Clemson to a big 38-3 win over Wake Forest in Week 7. The Tigers covered the 7.5-point spread, while the final score played UNDER the day's posted total of 48.

Miami defeated UCF 27-7 in Week 7 and covered the 13-point spread on the road. That game's 34 points went UNDER the posted total of 46.5 Javarris Harris threw for 299 yards with a touchdown for Miami.

Miami appears to be the pick for this game even though Clemson can be very dangerous and unpredictable. We also like the OVER on the 43 posted total.
