

## Indiana vs. Iowa College Football Picks

Indiana vs. Iowa College Football Picks: The No. 7 (AP) Iowa Hawkeyes will host the Indiana Hoosiers in a BIG TEN Conference game Saturday in an early 12-Noon ESPN2 televised game at Kinnick Stadium in Iowa City, Iowa. The Hawkeyes are currently undefeated at 8-0 and are in the BCS championship picture ranked in that poll at No. 4. There is a knock on the Hawkeyes regarding their championship prospects because of a few narrow escapes against questional competition.

College football picks experts at online super sportsbook BetUS.com list Iowa as 17 1/2-chalk favorites ATS versus Indiana with a 47 total. Hoosiers backers are getting +700 moneyline odds as a big road underdog while a wager on a SU Iowa win is -1000.

In spite of the Hoosiers 4-4 SU record, they are a surprising 5-2 ATS. The Hawkeyes are also 5-2 ATS while going 8-0 SU.

Current betting trends show the Hoosiers getting plenty of respect from side gamblers by getting 76% of the action ATS. Most gamblers (69%) are betting Iowa wins SU while 82% are wagering the total goes OVER the posted 47.

Darius Willis ran for 105 yards and two touchdowns for Indiana in a 29-28 loss to Northwestern in Week 8. The Hoosiers covered the 4.5-point spread, while the combined score played OVER the posted total of 53.

Receiver Marvin McNutt caught a last-second touchdown pass to keep Iowa undefeated, winning 15-13 over Michigan State at Spartan Stadium in Week 8. Iowa covered as a 2-point road underdog while the final score played under the 42-point total.
