

Georgia vs. Florida College Football Picks

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Florida vs. Georgia College Football Picks: To put it simply, the Georgia Bulldogs have not lived up to early season expectations by going 4-3 overall after seven games into the 2009 college football campaign. Today, the Bulldogs will be heavy underdogs as they travel down to Jacksonville, Fla., to play the No. 1 team in the land, the University of Florida Gators at Jacksonville Municipal Stadium. Florida is currently 7-0 overall and 5-0 in SEC play. This game will be televised nationally by CBS with a 3:30 pm ET kickoff.

College football picks experts at online super sportsbook BetUS.com list the Gators as heavy 14 1/2-chalk favorites versus the Bulldogs with a 49 1/2 total. Georgia backers are getting +550 moneyline odds as the underdog while a SU Florida winning wager is priced at -750.

Thanks to two touchdown passes from Joe Cox, Georgia took care of Vanderbilt 34-10 in Week 7. The Bulldogs covered the 7.5-point spread, while the final score played UNDER the day's posted total of 48.

Florida scored two touchdowns in the fourth quarter and came back for a 29-19 victory over Mississippi State in Week 8. Florida failed to cover the 22.5-point spread, while the 48 points went UNDER the posted total of 50. Chris Rainey led Florida with 82 yards rushing and a touchdown.
