College Football Week 10 odds list isn't as loaded with as many blockbuster games as will be on the lineup the next few weeks, but the week still has a few pretty good games. The one showcase contest for college football week 10 odds is LSU visiting Alabama for a huge SEC West showdown at Bryant-Denny Stadium in Tuscaloosa. The No. 9 (BCS) Tigers are probably the biggest hurdle facing the No. 3 Crimson Tide in their road to the SEC championship game in December. A win for LSU could also propel the Tigers into the BCS picture.

Odds makers at online sportsbook BetUS.com have installed Alabama as 7 1/2-chalk favorites versus LSU with a 38 total.

In the weeks only other matchup between ranked BCS teams, No. 11 Penn State hosts No. 16 Ohio State in a battle for a chance at the BIG TEN title. If the Buckeyes can defeat the Nittany Lions and then beat No. 4 Iowa next week, they will have the best chance of winning the championship. Penn State, like the Buckeyes, have a chance to share the conference title if they can win out and hope for an Ohio State victory over Iowa next week.

BetUS.com odds makers list the Nittany Lions as 4-chalk favorites versus the Buckeyes with a 39 1/2 total.

No. 22 Notre Dame will host unranked Navy in a game that gets traditional purists excited. While the game has little national impact, it is a classic matchup between traditional schools. The Irish need to keep winning to have a chance of getting a good BCS Bowl berth while a win over the Irish by the Middies would enhance their bowl chances.

Notre Dame is installed on the BetUS.com board as 11-chalk favorites versus the Midshipmen with a 55 1/2 total.

No. 5 Cincinnati will look to keep its overall and BIG EAST undefeated record unblemished when they play host to unranked Connecticut at Nippert Stadium on Saturday. With an 8-0 overall record, the Bearcats are in the thick of the BCS picture. They can't overlook the Huskies, who are a talent laden team and were one of the favorites to win the conference in the pre-season.

BetUS.com lists Cincinnati as -16 1/2 chalk favorites versus the Huskies with a 51 1/2 total.
