Central Florida vs. Texas College Football Picks: The No. 2 (BCS) ranked University of Texas Longhorns football team will step out of BIG 12 play this Saturday (Nov. 7) to host the University of Central Florida Knights of Conference-USA in a college football game at Texas Memorial Stadium in Austin. Kickoff for this FSN televised game is set for Noon ET.

College Football Picks oddsmakers at Sportsbook.com list the Longhorns as 35-chalk favorites versus the Knights with a 50 total.

While the Longhorns are currently 8-0 SU, gambling fans haven't been so fortunate backing the Longhorns ATS, especially in large point-spreads as today's game (Texas giving -35). In eight board lined games, Texas has only covered three times with one push and four losses. Texas failed to cover ATS against Louisiana-Monroe (-45), Wyoming (-31.5), Colorado (-34) and Texas Tech (-19.5). The only big spread Texas managed to cover was as a -36 favorite versus Texas El Paso. So if you're looking for a pretty good betting value, take UCF and the +35 points.

Central Florida defeated Marshall 21-20 as a 7-point favorite in Week 9. The combined score fell UNDER the posted over/under total (43). Brett Hodges passed for 342 yards with two touchdowns for UCF and Brynn Harvey rushed for 47 yards and a touchdown on 21 carries in the win. Texas scored 21 points in the second quarter en route to a 41-14 victory over Oklahoma State in Week 9. Texas easily covered the 9.5-point spread, while the 55 points made it OVER the posted total of 53.5.

Cody Johnson ran for 32 yards off nine carries with a pair of touchdowns.
